The Counterbalance forklift is a forklift that is designed along with a weight which counters the balance, equally distributing the weight of the load across the forklift arms. Counterbalance forklifts are designed so the weight behind the center of gravity is counterbalanced by the weight on the lift. The load is projected out from the front of the machinery so it is visible to the driver of the forklift. This particular type of forklift truck should just be utilized on level, stable ground or on a prepared surface.

Forklift drivers are needed to receive training which will allow them to better know the right or proper way across the forklift arms. The trainee will learn to correctly lower and raise the load vertically and how to tilt the mast of the lift truck, moving the mast between 5 and 15 degrees both backwards and forwards. Trainees will be taught the RTITB standards needed for safe forklift operation. Individuals training will also know the kinds of attachments for the forklift arms.

Types of Counterbalance Forklifts:

### **Walkie Pallet Trucks**

The counterbalance forklift known as the Walkie Pallet Truck is best suited for getting into spaces which are both small and cramped. This particular lift is highly maneuverable and could access practically every tight spot.

### **Walkie Stackers**

The Walkie Stacker is another forklift which differs slightly from the Walkie Pallet truck when it comes to its lift height. This equipment is designed to access tighter spaces and has extra lift capabilities for high stacking. None of the Walkie line of lifts can be ridden. The driver has to walk behind them.

### **Rider Pallet Trucks**

Rider Pallet Trucks are made to be ridden. These riding lifts are great for dock loading and unloading.

### **Wave Work Assist Vehicle**

The Wave Work Assist Vehicle is a counterbalance forklift intended to reach great heights of up to 17 feet.

### **Sit Down Counter Balanced Trucks**

The Sit-down Counterbalance Forklift is made in four-wheel and three-wheel forklift designs. These durable and tough trucks are designed to be ridden.
