Procedures regarding the general operation of the forklift is taught, in addition to startup, circle checks, shutdown, forward/reverse on level ground, and operating around other individuals. Load handling topics comprise selection of loads, load pickup and placements, loading and off-loading trailers and load security and integrity. Participants will learn operational maintenance procedures, like recharging and refueling. Safety concerns in the workplace would be talked about. Those participating would learn about the environmental conditions affecting the performance of the lift truck and be able to identify possible hazards. Advanced training on propane handling could be incorporated.

Employers and their employees might face penalties if they do not operate based on national and industry standards. Employees operating a counterbalance forklift should be knowledgeable about the safe operation guidelines of their forklift. Training is suggested for any person applying for a job that needs forklift operation.
