Nanaimo Order Picker License - Order preparation operation or order picking as it is more normally known is a method used within warehouse operations and consists of employees known as order pickers. The order picker's task is to take and collect articles in particular quantities to be able to complete the client's orders previous to shipment. Order picking is a basic warehousing process. The effectiveness in which this particular job is completed could be directly related to the productivity of a supply chain. Hence, order picking is among the most controlled logistic methods. Order picking falls in the category of the warehouse management system.

There are several specific types of order picking. The main kinds consist of: wave picking method, pick to box method, piece picking or picker to part method, sorting systems method and zone picking method.

The pick to box method involves the order picker filling the box with the stuff from his or her station. The box then moves to the other picking locations until the client order is finish. In this process, there is no movement of the order picker workers. In the wave picking method, the order pickers move about in order to gather the required items for some orders. The piece picking or picker to part method is similar where the order pickers or picker move in order to gather the items needed but for one order only.

In the sorting systems method, there is no movement of the order picking personnel. Instead, the products are brought to her or him through an automated system like automatic storage or a conveyor system. In the zone picking method, each order picker is assigned to one particular zone. They are responsible for just realizing order picking within this specific area.
