Each of these questions must be answered with "yes" if all the safety rules and regulations are being followed. A "no" to whatever question indicates a procedural flaw which may lead to accident, injury or damage to equipment.

- 1) Is the operating area of the forklift separate from the traffic of pedestrians?
- 2) Is pedestrian access to forklift travel areas restricted by barriers?
- 3) Are pedestrian walkways provided and well marked?
- 4) Are "forklift in operation" signs visibly clear?
- 5) Are mirrors for pedestrians and drivers provided at blind spots?
- 6) Are changes to daily forklift schedules communicated to all affected workers?
- 7) The forklift tires being used are suitable for all operating surfaces?
- 8) Is the seatbelt being utilized?
- 9) Is the seat in good condition?
- 10) Is a regular forklift maintenance schedule followed?
- 11) Are yearly checks of the forklift being done?
- 12) Is the forklift right for the needed tasks?
- 13) Is there a load chart that is readable on the forklift?
- 14) Could the operators understand and read the load chart?
- 15) The chart lists the safe lifting capacity for all attachments and their uses?
- 16) Do the forklift warning devices work right?
- 17) Is the operating speed control device fitted right?
- 18) The lift truck overhead cage is fitted correctly?
- 19) Do the operators of the forklift have certifications to use the machinery?
- 20) Speed limits and warning signs are being observed?
- 21) Are lift truck operators up to date on training for all kinds of lift trucks being operated?
- 22) Forklift operators know their responsibilities to report the damage to the machinery and other lift truck accidents?
- 23) Is the pre-test checklist reviewed each and every day prior to the machinery being utilized?
