Nanaimo Aerial Lift Ticket - Boom vehicle are often used by phone, cable television and utilities companies as they have long folded arms which are typically folded over the roofs of business vehicles. On the end of the extension of extendable arms typically sits a bucket-like apparatus. When a container truck has an extendable boom installed on the roof this is sometimes referred to as an "aerial boom truck" or a "cherry picker". It can transport staff to the peak of a telephone or utility pole. Bucket boom vehicles have a hauling capacity of roughly 350 lbs to 1500 lbs or 158 kg to 680 kg and are capable of extending the bucket up to 34 feet or to around 10 meters into the air.

Building boom trucks or heavy duty boom vehicles will regularly have a hoist accessory on the rear. Often referred to as knuckle booms, these cranes can be shorter and more compact than the trolley boom, which has a boom capable of extending the length of the truck. Crane boom vehicles have a hauling capability between 10 to 50 tons or just about 9 to 45 metric tons.

Concrete boom vehicles are an additional deviation. The booms on these lift trucks have a tube with a nozzle at the far end and are utilized to pump concrete or other materials. The areas where these materials have to be deposited is oftentimes inaccessible to the truck or is located at a great height, therefore, the boom of a bigger concrete boom vehicle may well be extended 230 feet or just about 71 meters. The vehicle then pumps the concrete through the boom precisely depositing it into the space where it is needed.

Fire engines are often fitted with a boom container able to hoist firefighters up to the upper floors of structures. In addition, this boom will allow firefighters to direct the flow of water or to engage or rescue ensnared victims. Many of the older hook and ladder trucks have been replaced by up to date boom trucks.

There is in addition a miniature self-propelled boom vehicle, analogous to a forklift that is offered on the market for large warehouses or production facilities. These mini boom vehicles may lift staff to upper storage areas or to the ceiling of the building. They are much safer and more stable than utilizing an extension ladder for the same application.
